

## MODIFIED CAREER PATH APPRECIATION (MCPA)

### What is it?

The MCPA is an on-line assessment that assesses an individual's:

- Current capability to manage complexity, ambiguity, and uncertainty
- Decision-making capability (operational through to strategic)
- Learning agility
- Theme of Work where he / she will experience 'flow' and engagement
- Rate of growth and identification of future potential
- Readiness for upward or lateral career movements

### The MCPA will be beneficial when you need to:

- Select the 'right people into the right roles' at all organisational levels
- Select or develop management through to executive level employees
- Increase the level of flow and engagement in your organisation
- Create a platform for mentoring, career path management, and competency development
- Develop talent pools for succession planning and leadership development programs

### Delivery of the MCPA involves a 2-part process:

- The candidate completes an Internet-based questionnaire designed to explore experience of and preferred approach to work

### Outputs of the MCPA:

- Candidates receive feedback immediately after their MCPA
- Organisations are provided with feedback
- Reports are made available to both organisations and candidates
